KG-2nd Grade:

We will introduce various gardening tips, ideas, the difference between perennials and annuals, and use creative thinking skills to map out the spring vegetable garden! We will even create some art for the garden!

Children will use creative and critical thinking skills to complete different missions and challenges. Children of all abilities are welcome. Students will have hands-on learning, while using problem solving and decision making skills to work cooperatively with others. This

class brings science and math to kids in a fun, creative, and challenging way!

Speed Stacking: \$45, presented by Mrs. Wright **This class is for 2nd-5th grades

Sport Stacking is an individual, small group, or team activity where participants stack and unstack 12 especially made cups in predetermined pyramids. Stackers race against the clock and in relays. Sport stacking helps students use both sides of their bodies and brains, promoting hand quickness and concentration. Sport stacking can challenge students to focus on hand-eye coordination and reaction time-important skills for almost any sport or physical activity. Every student, no matter what his or her athletic ability, can find success with sport stacking!
